Designing and planning of paintings (painting sketch). Project realisation based on a study (study of still life, study of interior, study of landscape, portrait and self-portrait, study of a person). Getting to know expressive techniques in 2D. The basics of the shape of an artistic work. Synthetic observation of nature. Classes on a free interpretation of nature. Classes based on the use of intuition and imagination. Individual selection of a theme and aim in painting Individual and conscious project realisation

Teaching methods

Classes are run by a tutor. One to one tutorials. Assistance during the initial and final stages of a project is provided.
